


BIBLE STORY FISHING

MATERIALS:

- Fish Patterns
- Magnet
- Fishing pole
- Tape
- Paperclips
- String




DESCRIPTION:


Students “fish” for questions to answer about the bible story.

DIRECTIONS:

- Make copies of the fish pattern onto colorful paper (preferably cardstock).
- Laminate the pages.
- Cut out the fish.
- Clip a paperclip to the mouth of fish. Tape the paperclip on the backside to keep the paperclip from coming off.
- Make a fishing pole out of wooden rod or piece of PVC pipe by taping a 3 foot piece of string to the pole and by adding a magnet to the end to serve as a “hook”.
- Lay out the fish on the floor with the questions face up.
- Divide the class into two groups.
- Have the teams alternate by “fishing” for a question. Students will lower the magnet to the paperclip attached to the fish that they choose.
- Once the fish is “caught”, the team member reads and answers the question aloud. If the question is answered correctly, the player scores 2 points for his/her team. If the question is answered incorrectly, the other team can answer it for 1 point.
- The next team repeats the previous step.
- The team with the most points, after all of the fish are gone, wins.














