

BIBLE STORY VOLLEYBALL

MATERIALS:

- Beach Ball
- Permanent Marker
- Masking Tape



DESCRIPTION:

Students answer bible story review questions when the beach ball falls.

DIRECTIONS:

- Buy a beach ball and write the questions listed below on the ball in permanent marker.
- Use masking tape for the center dividing line.
- Divide the class into two teams.
- The teacher throws the ball to a team to begin the game.
- Teams hit the ball back and forth until the ball falls onto the ground.
- Someone from the team where the ball falls picks the ball up with two hands and answers the question nearest the person's right thumb. If the question is answered correctly, the person who answered the question earns one point for his/her team.
- If the question is answered incorrectly, the other team earns 2 points.
- The ball is given back to the teacher who tosses the ball back into play.
- Repeat.
- The team with the most points at the end of the play period wins.

QUESTIONS:

- What was the problem in the bible story?
- How was the problem solved in the bible story?
- Describe the setting in the story.
- Who were the characters in the story?
- What is something from the bible story that I can apply to my life?
- What is the scripture reference for the bible story?
- Summarize the bible story in three sentences or less.
- Pick a character from the bible story. Describe the character using only three words.
- What is one thing that you learned from the bible story?
- Summarize the bible story using 10 words or less.
- If you were to tell this bible story to a younger brother or sister, what is the one thing that you would want him or her to know?
- Describe the part of the bible story that was the most interesting to you.
- If you could interview one of the characters from the bible story, what would you ask?
- What lesson can be learned from the bible story?
- Make up your own generic review questions!
