Mark 13

¹As he was leaving the temple, one of his disciples said to him, “Look, Teacher! What massive stones! What magnificent buildings!”

²“Do you see all these great buildings?” replied Jesus. “Not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down.”

³As Jesus was sitting on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple, Peter, James, John and Andrew asked him privately, ⁴“Tell us, when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that they are all about to be fulfilled?”

⁵Jesus said to them: “Watch out that no one deceives you. ⁶Many will come in my name, claiming, ‘I am he,’ and will deceive many. ⁷When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. ⁸Nation will rise against

nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places, and famines. These are the beginning of birth pains.

⁹“You must be on your guard. You will be handed over to the local councils and flogged in the synagogues. On account of me you will stand before governors and kings as witnesses to them.

¹⁰And the gospel must first be preached to all nations.

¹¹Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit.

¹²“Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child. Children will rebel against their parents and have them put to death. ¹³All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.





CRAFT/ACTIVITY: BOOKS

Students will make books to remind them of some of the signs of the end of the age.

MATERIALS

1. 67 lb. White Cardstock
2. Book Pattern
3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
4. Scissors



DIRECTIONS

1. Make a copy of the “Book Pattern” onto 67 lb. cardstock for each student.
2. Have students color a picture to go with the caption on each page with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
3. Allow students to cut out the book on the solid black lines. Study the diagram above carefully. The first time you make one of these books it can be confusing. There is a small solid line in the middle of the page that must be cut as well.
4. Fold the book according to the diagram above.
5. Have students retell the story using the pictures in their books.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are drawing pictures, remind them that many things will happen before the end of the age comes. These things will be signs that the end is near. As believers, we should see these signs as a call to action. Our job is to spread the gospel message before it is too late.





Jesus’ disciples wanted to know when this would happen. Jesus began teaching the disciples of things to come. Jesus told the disciples that the end of the age will come when certain things happen. One of the signs will be wars and rumors of wars. Jesus warned to watch out for people who will pretend to be the Messiah. Other signs will include earthquakes and famines. Finally, the gospel must also be preached to all nations.

Jesus told his disciples that they should be on their guard. They may be arrested and beaten because they follow after Jesus.

Some other things that will happen at the end of the age will include brother betraying brother, children rebelling against their parents and having them put to death. Also, others will hate believers of Jesus. But Jesus promised that those who stand firm until the end will be saved.
