³⁵"The tenants seized his servants; they beat one, killed another, and stoned a third. ³⁶Then he sent other servants to them, more than the first time, and the tenants treated them the same way. ³⁷Last of all, he sent his son to them. 'They will respect my son,' he said.

³⁸ But when the tenants saw the son, they said to each other, 'This is the heir. Come, let's kill him and take his inheritance.' ³⁹So they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him.

⁴⁵When the chief priests and the Pharisees heard Jesus' parables, they knew he was talking about them. ⁴⁶They looked for a way to arrest him, but they were afraid of the crowd because the people held that he was a prophet.



CRAFT/ACTIVITY: VINE NECKLACES

Students will make a vine necklace to remind them that a landowner planted a vineyard and rented it to some farmers.

MATERIALS

- 1. 67 lb. Cardstock
- 2. Vine Pattern
- 3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Glue
- 6. Yarn (two feet per student)
- 7. Hole Punch

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Make copies of the "Vine Pattern" onto 67lb. cardstock for each student.
- 2. Have students color the leaves and grapes.
- 3. Have students cut out the grapes and leaves as one piece.
- 4. Punch a hole through the black dot.
- 5. String a piece of yarn that is 2 feet long through the hole and tie the ends together.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their vine necklaces, remind them that the tenants in the story represent the Jews, or their leaders. The servants represent the old testament prophets. The son represents Christ who was condemned to death by religious leaders. In verse 41, the other tenants represent the Gentiles who heard the gospel message and accepted it. Over and over God revealed himself to his people, but many rejected the truth. Help students realize that God, through his word, is calling out to them as well. He does not want his children to hear the gospel message and reject it. Give students an opportunity to receive Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.


