¹“At that time the kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ²Five of them were foolish and five were wise. ³The foolish ones took their lamps but did not take any oil with them. ⁴The wise, however, took oil in jars along with their lamps. ⁵The bridegroom was a long time in coming, and they all became drowsy and fell asleep.

⁶“At midnight the cry rang out: ‘Here’s the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!’

⁷“Then all the virgins woke up and trimmed their lamps.

⁸The foolish ones said to the wise, ‘Give us some of your oil; our lamps are going out.’

⁹“‘No,’ they replied, ‘there may not be enough for both

us and you. Instead, go to those who sell oil and buy some for yourselves.’

¹⁰“But while they were on their way to buy the oil, the bridegroom arrived. The virgins who were ready went in with him to the wedding banquet. And the door was shut.

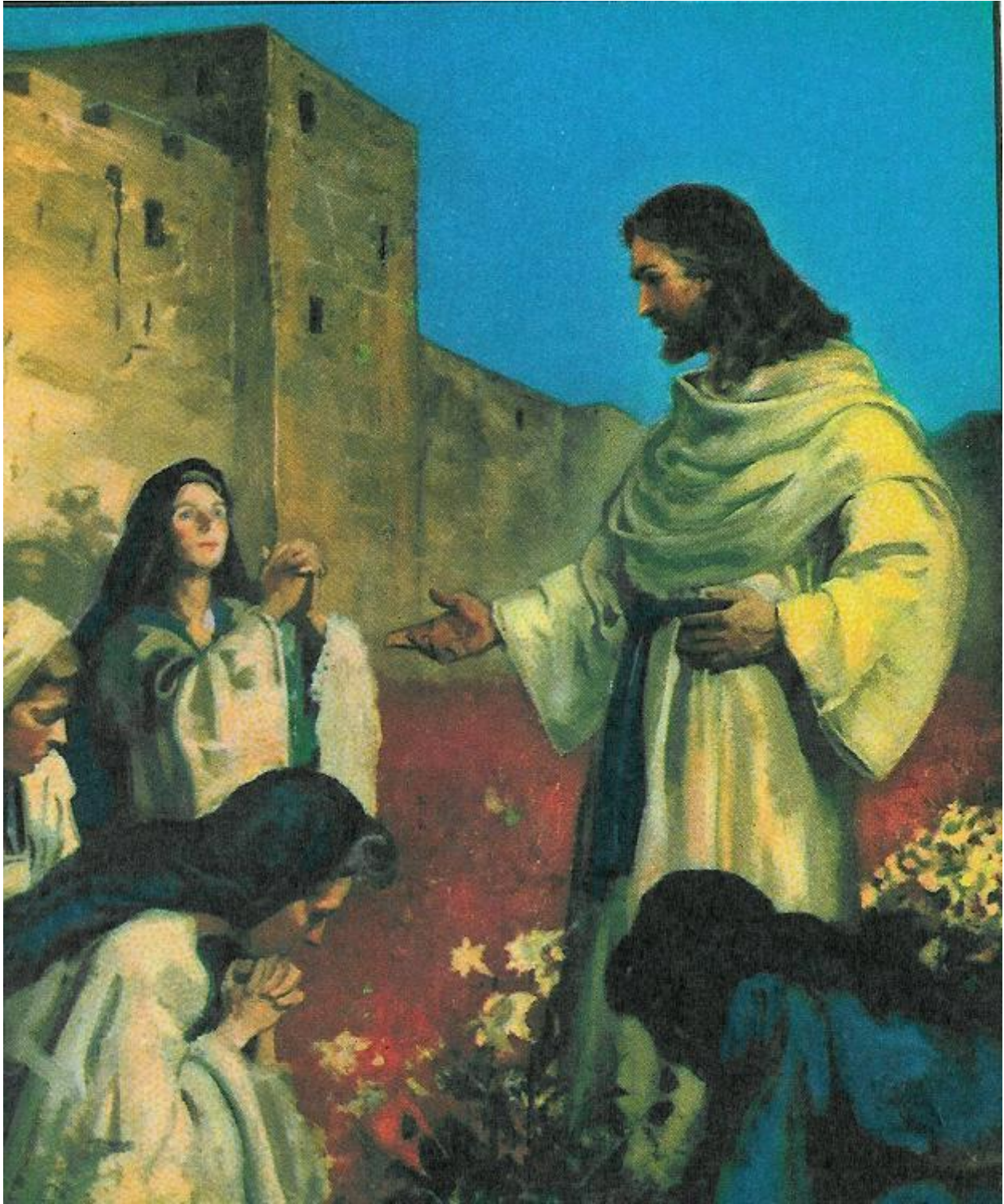

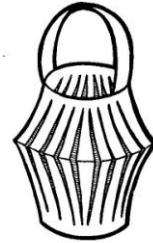

CRAFT/ACTIVITY: LANTERNS

Students will make a lantern to remind them that five of the ten virgins had their lamps ready when they went to meet the bridegroom.

MATERIALS

1. 67 lb. Cardstock
2. Lantern Pattern
3. Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
4. Scissors
5. Glue or Tape



DIRECTIONS

1. Make copies of the lantern pattern onto 67lb. cardstock for each student.
2. Have students color the lantern.
3. Have students cut on the solid black lines and fold on the dotted lines.
4. Glue or tape the two tabs together.
5. Glue or tape the handle on the lantern.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their lanterns, remind them that five of the ten virgins were ready for the bridegroom and five were not. Help students realize that we need to be ready at all times for the return of Christ. Without Christ as our Savior, we are not adequately ready for His return. As our memory verse indicates, we do not know when Christ will return.
