John 15:1-17

John 15

¹“I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ²He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ³You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

⁵“I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.

⁸This is to my Father’s glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

⁹“As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in

my love. ¹⁰If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father’s commands and remain in his love. ¹¹I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. ¹²My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. ¹⁴You are my friends if you do what I command. ¹⁵I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master’s business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. ¹⁶You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit—fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. ¹⁷This is my command: Love each other.







CRAFT/ACTIVITY: GRAPE CLUSTERS

Students will make a grape cluster to remind them that Jesus is the vine and we are the branches.

MATERIALS

1. 67 lb. Cardstock
2. Grape Cluster Pattern
3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
4. Small Marshmallows
5. Red Food Coloring
6. Large Zipper Bag
7. Glue



DIRECTIONS

1. Make copies of the grape cluster pattern onto 67lb. cardstock for each student.
2. Have students color the leaves of the grape cluster. They do not need to color the grapes.
3. Before several hours before class (or the night before), fill a zipper bag with marshmallows and several drops of red food coloring. Zip the bag shut and shake until the marshmallows turn red. Unzip the bag and let the marshmallows dry out. It will make gluing the marshmallows easier.
4. Glue a marshmallow in each circle to represent red grapes.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their grape clusters, remind them that to bear fruit we must remain on the vine. Help students realize that the vine is Jesus, and we are the branches. For our Christian lives to bear any fruit, we must cling to him.






