Acts 2

¹When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ²Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

⁵Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. ⁶When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking in his own language. ⁷Utterly amazed, they asked: “Are not all these men who are speaking Galileans? ⁸Then

how is it that each of us hears them in his own native language? ⁹Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome ¹¹(both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!”

¹²Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, “What does this mean?”

¹³Some, however, made fun of them and said, “They have had too much wine.”

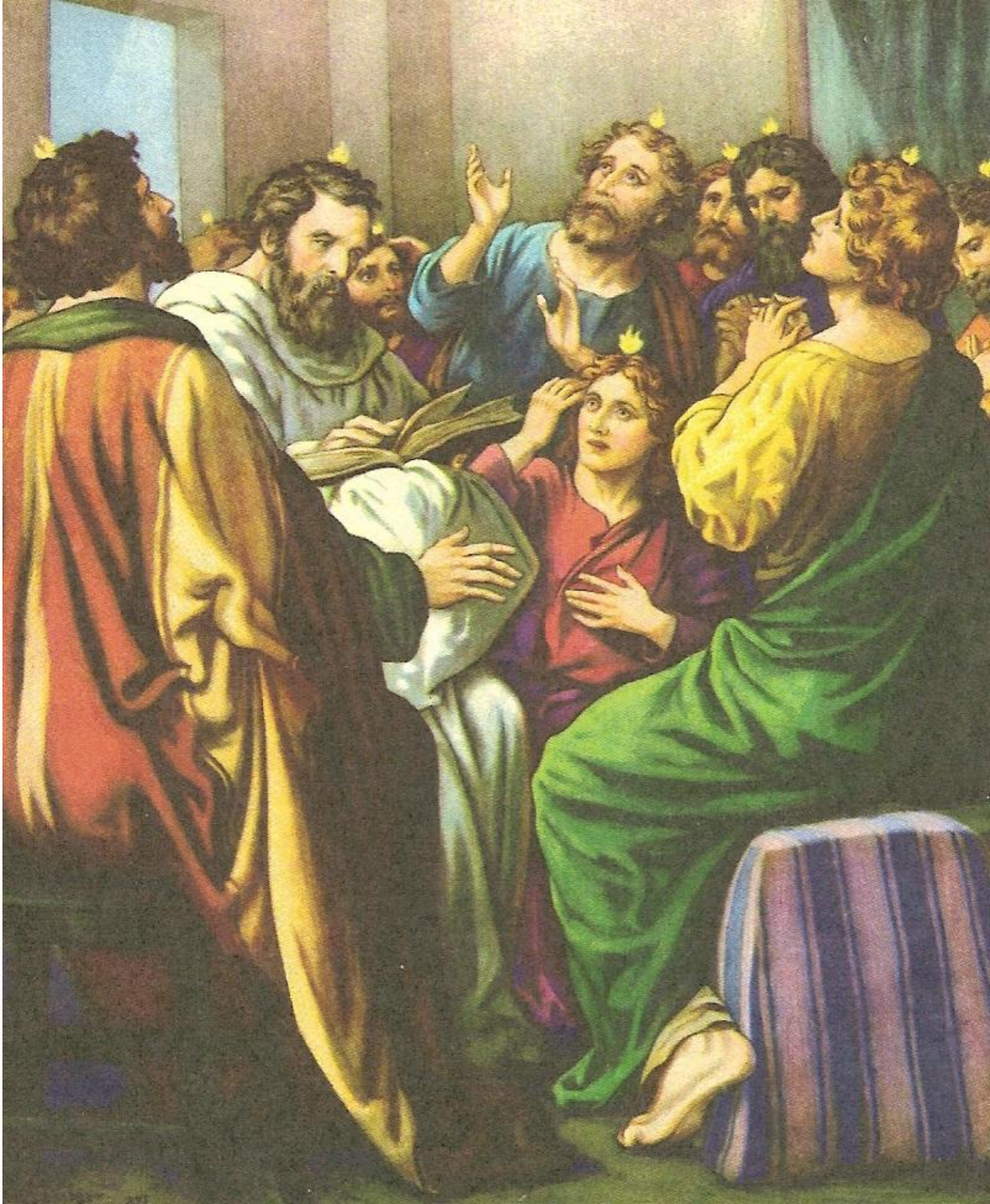

CRAFT/ACTIVITY: HEADBANDS

Students will make a “tongue of fire” headband to help remind them that the Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost.

MATERIALS

1. 67 lb. Cardstock
2. Tongue of Fire Headband Pattern
3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
4. Tape
5. Scissors



DIRECTIONS

1. Make copies of the “Tongue of Fire Headband Pattern” for each student onto 67 lb. cardstock.
2. Have students color the “tongue of fire” with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
3. Allow students to cut out the “tongue of fire” and the headbands on the solid black lines.
4. Tape the “tongue of fire” to the headband pieces.
5. Tape the two headband pieces together around each student’s head.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their headbands, remind them that Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit when he ascended to Heaven. The Holy Spirit, also called the Counselor, was sent to guide us in all truth. Help students realize that when they ask Jesus into their hearts, the Holy Spirit dwells in them.

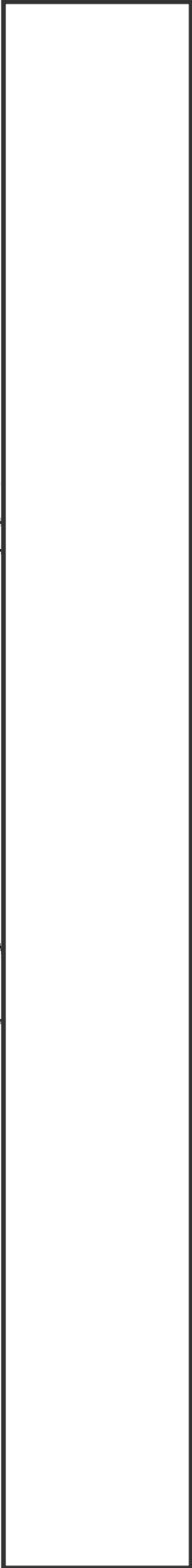
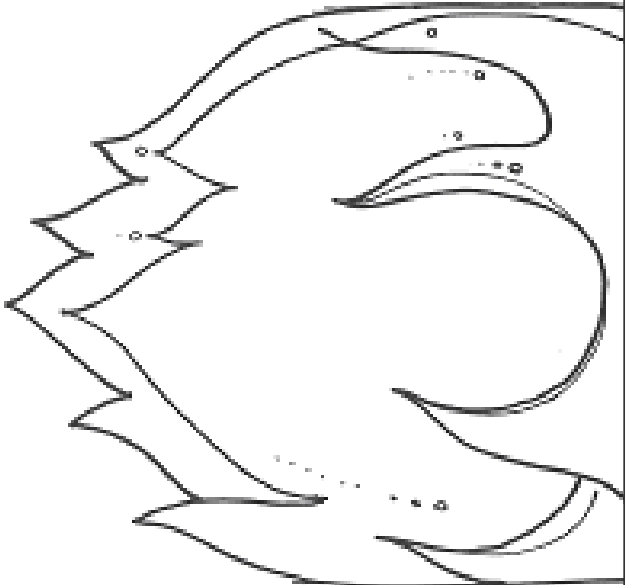
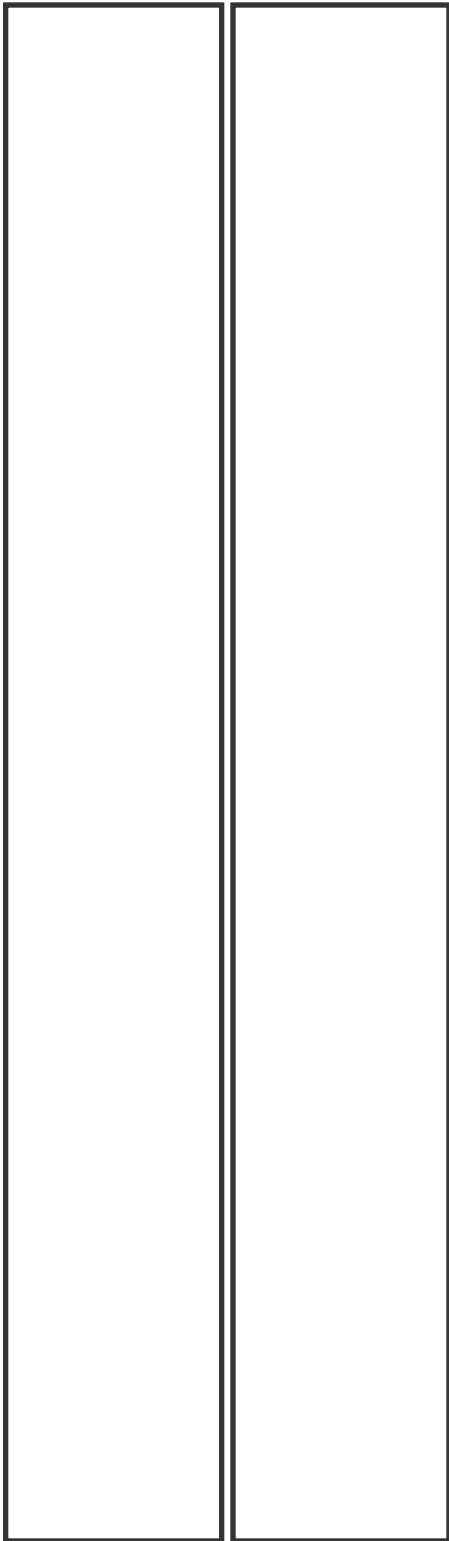

TONGUE OF FIRE HEADBAND PATTERN

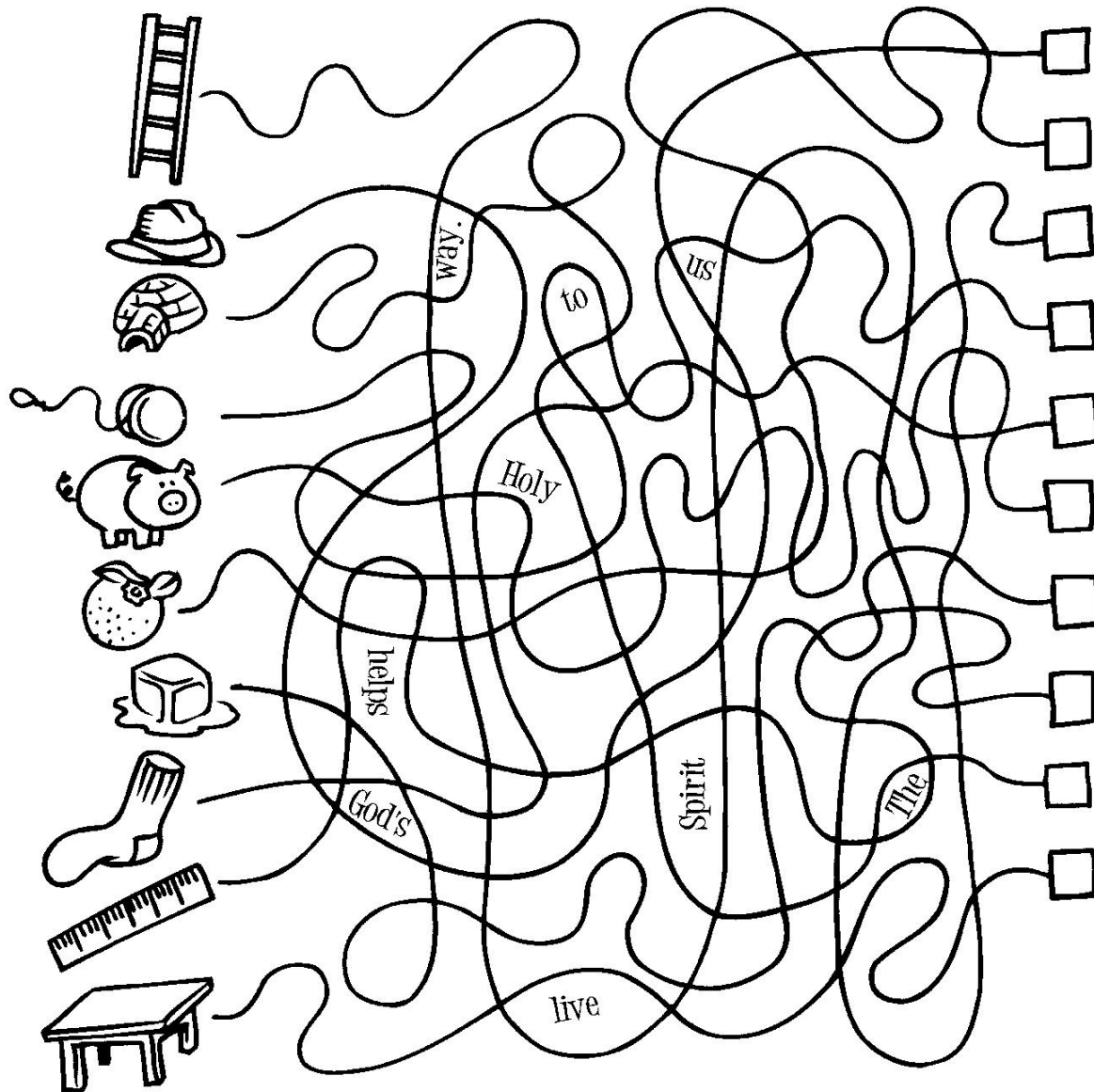

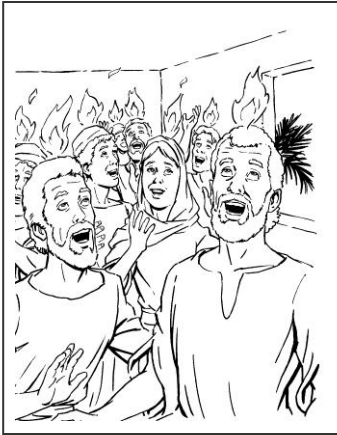

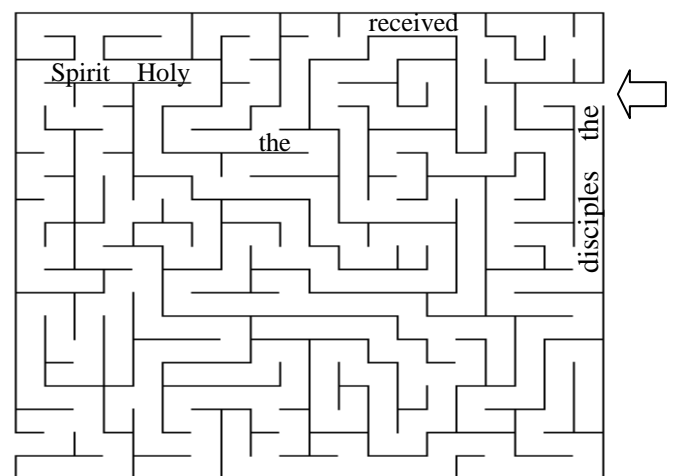
