Saul spent several days with the disciples in Damascus. ²⁰At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God. ²¹All those who heard him were astonished and asked, "Isn't he the man who raised havoc in Jerusalem among those who call on this name? And hasn't he come here to take them as prisoners to the chief priests?" ²²Yet Saul grew more and more powerful and baffled the Jews living in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Christ.

²³After many days had gone by, the Jews conspired to kill him, ²⁴but Saul learned of their plan. Day and night they kept close watch on the city gates in order to kill him. ²⁵But his followers took him by night and lowered him in a basket through an opening in the wall.

²⁶When he came to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples, but

they were all afraid of him, not believing that he really was a disciple. 27But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. He told them how Saul on his journey had seen the Lord and that the Lord had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had preached fearlessly in the name of Jesus. ²⁸So Saul stayed with them and moved about freely in Jerusalem, speaking boldly in the name of the Lord. ²⁹He talked and debated with the Grecian Jews, but they tried to kill him. ³⁰When the brothers learned of this, they took him down to Caesarea and sent him off to Tarsus.

³¹Then the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria enjoyed a time of peace. It was strengthened; and encouraged by the Holy Spirit, it grew in numbers, living in the fear of the Lord.





Acts 9:19-31

CRAFT/ACTIVITY: PAUL IN A BASKET

Students will make a basket to remind them of how Paul's friends helped him get away by lowering him in a basket through a hole in the wall.

MATERIALS

- 1. White 67 lb. Cardstock
- 2. Basket Pattern
- 3. Scissors
- 4. Crayons
- 5. Tape or Glue
- 6. Paper Towels
- 7. Yarn (10" pieces)
- 8. Hole Punch



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Copy a "Basket Pattern" onto 67 lb. cardstock for each student.
- 2. Have students color the basket (front and back) and the Paul figure.
- 3. Cut out the basket and Paul figure on the solid black lines.
- 4. Have students fold on the dotted lines.
- 5. Tape or glue the tabs to construct the basket.
- 6. Glue Paul to the bottom of the basket.
- 7. Lay a piece of paper towel (blanket) over Paul to hide him in the basket.
- 8. Punch four holes in the basket and tie two pieces of yarn to the basket to represent ropes.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their baskets, remind them of how Paul's friends helped him escape so that he could continue to spread the good news of Christ to the world. Ask students what they would do to further God's kingdom.






