

Weekly Lesson Planning

- Monday - Read the Bible story from the Bible. Pray and ask God to show you what the main idea or theme of the story is, and three main points that your students should walk out of Sunday School with.
- Tuesday - Read the Bible story from the Bible. Pray and ask God to show you how to connect the story to the students' lives. Consider how to explain the memory verse for the week to your students.
- Wednesday - Read the Bible story from the Bible. Pray and ask God to show you how to help students see how the lesson can be applied to their lives.
- Thursday - Read the Bible story from the Bible. Gather objects, pictures, clothes, or other visual aids to tell the Bible story with.
- Friday - Read the Bible story from Egermeier's Bible Story Book. Write down how you will connect the story to the students' own lives, the main idea or theme of the story, 3 main points from the story, how this Bible story can be applied to the lives of your students, and the meaning of the memory verse.
- Saturday - Read the Bible story from the Bible. Practice telling the Bible story from memory.
- Sunday - Get to church 20 minutes before the service to begin to prepare your room. Pray.
