Matthew 14

²²Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. ²³After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, ²⁴but the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it.

²⁵During the fourth watch of the night Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. ²⁶When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear.

²⁷But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."

²⁸"Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water."

²⁹"Come," he said.

Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. ³⁰But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!"

³¹Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

³²And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. ³³Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."



CRAFT/ACTIVITY: OCEAN SCENE

Students will make an ocean scene to remind them that Jesus walked on water.

MATERIALS

- 1. Blue Construction Paper
- 2. Boat Pattern and Jesus & Peter Pattern
- 3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencil
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Glue
- 6. Paper Fasteners
- 7. Popsicle Sticks



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Make copies of the "Boat Pattern and the Jesus & Peter Pattern" for each student.
- 2. Have students color Jesus, Peter, and the ship with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
- 3. Have students cut out Jesus, Peter, and the boat.
- 4. Color waves on the blue construction paper.
- 5. Push a paper fastener through the black hole in the bottom of the ship and attach it to the wave.
- 6. Glue sticks to the Jesus & Peter stick figures.
- 7. Have students retell the story by moving the ship back and forth while having Jesus walk on the water. Then have Peter walk on water, loose faith, and begin to sink.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their ocean scenes, help them realize that Peter was walking on water until he stopped looking at Jesus and lost faith. Help students realize that they must continually look to Jesus and live by faith.




JESUS AND JOHN PATTERN


