

CRAFT/ACTIVITY: CROSSES

Students will make crosses with Jesus' hands and feet to remind them that Jesus was nailed to a cross, died, rose again, and showed his hands and feet to his disciples.

MATERIALS

- 1. 67 lb. Cardstock
- 2. Blue Construction Paper
- 3. Feet, Hands, and Cross Pattern
- 4. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
- 5. Glue
- 6. Scissors



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Make copies of the "Feet, Hands, and Cross" Pattern for each student onto 67 lb. cardstock.
- 2. Have students color the feet, hands, and cross with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
- 3. Allow students to cut out the feet, hands, and cross on the solid black lines.
- 4. Glue the cross to the center of the blue construction paper.
- 5. Glue the hands and feet where they would be on the cross.

For Discussion

As students are working on their cross pictures, help them realize that it was necessary for Christ to die on the cross for their sins. The Bible teaches that without the shedding of blood, there is no remission of sins. Jesus was the perfect lamb that was slain on our behalf so they we would not have to pay for our own sins. The price has already been paid.






